The J.P. Morgan ACCESS Dashboard provides instant access to business-critical information immediately upon logging into the secure J.P. Morgan ACCESS portal. Summary data from multiple underlying applications is provided, with the ability to drill down to detailed information.

Multiple Dashboard views can be created, each one entirely customizable to meet unique data requirements. A sample Dashboard view with all its components is shown on the following page.

The J.P. Morgan ACCESS Dashboard hosts summary data from the following applications, with the ability to then drill through to more detailed information.

- **Views Portfolio Reporting:** Powerful and easy-to-use flagship reporting platform, with market-leading scheduling, customization and delivery capabilities.
- **Transaction Initiation:** Instruction capture across trade and cash settlement instructions.
- **Corporate Action Instructions:** Corporate action notification and instruction tool.
- **Performance Measurement:** Management tool for reviewing performance data in any currency, for realized or unrealized data, and broken out into user-specified groupings.
- **Compliance Reporting:** Provides valuable exemption-based information, highlighting potential warnings and violations to pre-agreed rules, tests and frequencies.
- **Market Intelligence:** Gives users the ability to monitor market events that impact their investment holdings.
- **E-Tax:** A convenient data source for meeting the needs of tax professionals, operations groups and investment managers.

1 Multiple snapshots provide summary information from underlying J.P. Morgan ACCESS tools, with the ability to drill down to further detail.

2 Users can display their favorite reports directly on the Dashboard, for review immediately upon logging on to J.P. Morgan ACCESS. For both manually run and scheduled reports, the Dashboard will display the last-run version of the selected report.

By clicking the Queries tab, users also have immediate access to the Quick Queries available through Views Portfolio Reporting.

3 Create multiple Watch Lists and assign stocks to them. Last price and visual up/down indicators are provided, with the option to view day change, high, low, volume and PE ratio. Track and view five-day trend information from multiple market indices.

4 Review various news feeds from a single location. Information is provided from the Market Intelligence and E-Tax applications, J.P. Morgan's Network Management group, Reuters and the J.P. Morgan Investment Bank.

5 Alerts and messages from the J.P. Morgan ACCESS portal are grouped together. Information is provided regarding the J.P. Morgan ACCESS portal itself and its underlying applications.
